

Olympic Torch Relay Evening Celebration, Madejski Stadium Reading

Terms and conditions

1. No alcohol or food will be permitted to be brought into the arenas.
2. Admittance to the venue is with a valid ticket only
3. Persons will not be admitted if in the opinion of the stewards they are under the influence of alcohol or an illegal substance.
4. Tickets are non-replaceable, non-exchangeable.
5. Children under 16 must have a valid ticket and be accompanied by an adult. Proof of age may be requested upon entry. Original tickets must be retained at all times during the Event.
6. Prohibited items not allowed on site are glass items, barbecues, candles or flaming torches.
7. Smoke effects, strobe lighting, lasers and loud noises may be used at the event. Prolonged exposure to loud noise may cause damage to your hearing.
8. A security search may be carried out.
9. We reserve the right to refuse admission. No re-admission is permitted under any circumstances.
10. We reserve the right to make any alteration to the advertised details for the performance.
11. Tickets are strictly limited to 4 per household, in the event of a household submitting multiple only one booking will be fulfilled.
12. Ticket holders release the organisers including the Reading Borough Council, Madejski Stadium, (CCS), London Organising Committee of the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games Limited (LOCOG), the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) from any liability for any loss or damage to personal property that may be suffered in relation to the event. Except as required by law, none of the organisers including RBC, MS, LOCOG, the IOC or the IPC shall have any liability to ticket holders.
13. Tickets may not be sold (including by way of auction) nor advertised for sale. Tickets may not be used for advertising, promotion, fundraising or marketing purposes (including in competitions, contests and sweepstakes).

14. Ticket holders understand that the arrangements for the event may be affected by circumstances beyond the control of the organisers, which may result in the delay, postponement or cancellation of the event without notice and neither the organisers nor LOCOG shall have any liability to ticket holders in respect of such delay, postponement or cancellation.

15. Ticket holders consent to being filmed, photographed and recorded and understand that photographs, films or recordings of ticket holders may be broadcast, published, licensed or used in perpetuity (without payment).

16. Ticket holders agree that any images, videos, or sound recordings taken at the event may only be used for private and domestic purposes and cannot be used for any commercial purposes, whether on the internet or otherwise.

17. Ticket holders may not engage in any activity which the organisers consider to be related to unauthorised marketing or advertising (including, for the avoidance of doubt, individual or group ambush marketing). The organiser reserves the right to refuse admission to, or eject from, the premises any person who fails to comply with this restriction.

18. No animals will be permitted, other than guide dogs for the blind and/or hearing dogs for the deaf/assistance dogs for disabled attendees
